Founded in 1850, Illinois Wesleyan is a private, co-educational university that is perennially recognized among the nation's leading liberal arts institutions. The University has an enrollment of 2,100 students from 33 states and 23 countries. With 184 faculty scholars, the student-faculty ratio is 11 to 1 and the average class size is 17. The University offers 50 major areas of study, pre-professional and professional programs in the fine arts and nursing. Illinois Wesleyan's five most popular majors are business administration, psychology, accounting, english and biology.

A liberal arts education at Illinois Wesleyan allows students to discover the interconnectedness of knowledge through a challenging course of study beyond their majors. The University places emphasis on developing critical thinking and communication skills, strengthening cultural literacy, and helping students become more globally aware and ethically grounded.
