IWU agrees to provide you an opportunity for employment during the 2011-2012 academic year as indicated in your award proposal. **All students with employment eligibility have the responsibility of securing a job of their choice.** If you should decide not to accept or later to resign from a job, the Financial Aid Office reserves the right to adjust your financial assistance accordingly. Such an adjustment could mean that your family contribution is increased. If you are either terminated or choose to quit your job, your remaining job eligibility is removed from your financial assistance with the understanding you have forfeited your opportunity to work this year. Depending upon availability of jobs, you may find another job only after all other need-based students on the waiting list have secured employment. The University student employment policy is ten hours per week but if you are approved to work more than that however, due to federal regulations you can not work over a total of twenty hours per week.
