Climate Change & Energy	F	The university has installed high-efficiency windows in several campus buildings and replaced emergency battery units with a generator. See complete survey data
Food & Recycling	C	Dining services purchases some organic fruits, vegetables, and dairy products. Fair trade coffee is served. Preshrunk, the campus thrift store, collects pre-owned items that would otherwise go the landfill. The university has an electronics recycling program and is exploring composting on a community-wide basis. See complete survey data
Green Building	С	All new buildings will earn LEED certification, and the university's Minor Myers Welcome Center is certified LEED Silver. The university has performed lighting retrofits in several campus buildings to adopt more energy-efficient lighting instruments. See complete survey data
Student Involvement	C	The university employs several student sustainability educators who serve as resources to the Illinois Wesleyan community. The Sierra Student Coalition chapter is working to bring trayless dining to the campus and increase the amount of local and organic food served.
