**Organization History:**

The College Alumni Club was organized December 5, 1890 at the home of Dr. James B. Taylor, a professor of Natural Science at Illinois Wesleyan University. The club was founded to address the need for a group of college men to assemble and discuss issues of significance as well as to promote fellowship amongst college graduates. It is one of the oldest continuous clubs in the area, and holds dinner meetings monthly, where a paper is read and then discussed after the meal.

**Scope & Content Note:**

This is a collection of documents relating to the College Alumni Club, transferred on behalf of the organization by Forrest Frank. The documents range from information about the club to the essays written by its members. It has been arranged in the following series:
