

May Term Fee

Students enrolled in any Illinois Wesleyan University course at 12:00 midnight on **Wednesday, May 2, 2012** (the first day of class), will be charged the flat \$500 fee for May Term to cover administrative and instructional costs. The fee will be reflected on the student's bill of May 15. With the exemption of travel courses (see list below), there will be no exemptions to the May Term fee.

Students should be aware that some on-campus May Term offerings require a course fee that is in addition to the May Term fee. Course fees are used to fund field trips, special equipment or other course needs, and should be paid directly to the May Term Office.

While Illinois Wesleyan does not provide any IWU assistance (loans or grants) for May Term charges, students can pursue Private Educational Loans or PLUS (Federal Parent Loans). You can find more information on these two options at:
