The Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) provides students with an opportunity to enjoy paid internships, free summer housing, learning opportunities and fun activities.

As participants of the program, students will have formal professional training, learn from various workshops, and participate in at least one major civic project. These activities will be designed to enhance students' team building and leadership skills.

## Eligibility

The program is available to Multiracial, African-American, Latino/a, Asian-American and Native American students the summer after their first, sophomore or junior year.

## Internships: Professional Growth

The purpose of the internships is to ensure students have meaningful professional experiences. Everything within the internship will be designed to enhance and improve the students' specific skill needs. As part of this individual attention, the students will also receive feedback and coaching from their internship manager and the Director of Multicultural Student Affairs.

## Course Credit Opportunity: Academic Growth

Participants have an option to take a class at a neighboring college. Which class the students take depends on their major or interest. Class selection is also dependent upon the Illinois Wesleyan University registrar's acceptance of the course and available resources. The tuition for the class is paid by SEP if the student receives a grade of 'C' or above in the class.

## Goal Setting: Personal Growth

The Director of Multicultural Student Affairs will work directly with the students to set aggressive individual goals that will challenge and aid them in their personal growth. This will be achieved, in part, by one-on-one meetings with the Director.
