- Illinois Wesleyan is believed to be the first team in league history to return two conference "Players of the Year" on the same squad - Adam Dauksas won the CCIW honor last season (as a junior) and Keelan Amelianovich was the league's most outstanding player in 2004 (as a sophomore).
- The senior-laden team has won 20 games, been league champions and NCAA entrants for three straight seasons with a three-season record of 64-18 (.780 winning percentage).
- The Titans had an exhibition trip to Costa Rica in late August and will play an exhibition game against Division I Illinois on Nov. 3 in a game that will showcase two schools (40 minutes apart geographically) that earned No. 1 midseason national rankings in their respective divisions.
- Senior guard Adam Dauksas was first team Division III All-American by both the NABC and D3hoops.com, NABC Midwest Region "Player of the Year", D3hoops.com all-Midwest region, and "Most Outstanding Player" in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin. . . Dauksas averaged 15.1 points and 5.6 assists in leading IWU to a 21-5 season. He was the team's leading scorer in seven games and his 145 assists is the fifth highest total in an IWU single season. . . After three seasons Dauksas is No. 4 at the school with 380 career assists and is No. 34 with 1,040 points. His 135 career 3-pointers is tied for sixth and his 277 made free throws is 15th. . . His .793 free throw percentage (277-of-349) makes him No. 7 among IWU players with 250 or made in a career.
- Senior forward Keelan Amelianovich was a second team D3hoops.com All-American and a first team all-CCIW selection in 2005, he averaged a team-high 17.9 points per game and led IWU in scoring in 13 games. He scored in double figures in 24 of 26 games. . . He is No. 4 at IWU with 155 3-point field goals and his 994 points makes him No. 37 among Titan career scorers. . . As a junior he was a first team All-American (NABC), second team on the D3hoops.com squad and third team in Basketball Times magazine. He was the CCIW "Most Outstanding Player" and the NABC Midwest Region "Player of the Year."
- Junior forward Zach Freeman missed four games due to a foot injury but still averaged 14.2 points and 6.8 rebounds while shooting .552 from the field. He was second team all-conference after being third team as a freshman.
- Other returning starters are forward Chris Jones, who took over from his twin brother Cory when he was injured early in the season, and guard Matt Arnold, who became a starter midseason.
