



Illinois Wesleyan vs. North Central November 1, 2008 Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium, Naperville, Ill.

THE GAME: Illinois Wesleyan (5-2, 2-2 College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) travels to face No. 2-ranked North Central (7-0, 4-0 CCIW) in a 1 p.m. game at Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium in Naperville.

LOOKING AHEAD: IWU will play again next week on the road against Wheaton at 1 p.m. The final regular season Titan game of the year will be at home vs. North Park at 1 p.m. on Nov.15.

ON THE AIR: The IWU/North Central game will be broadcast live on the Internet at www.wjbc2.com.

OCTOBER: In the Norm Eash coaching tenure, Wesleyan is 59-38 in October...IWU is 2-2 this year and the Titans were 4-0 in October in 2007.

ON TO THE NEXT 500: IWU is 516-383-42 (.571) in 116+ football seasons... The 500th win came in a 23-14 win over Wheaton on Oct. 22, 2005.

FOR THE RECORD: IWU is 83-46 in its last 128 games (.640) since 1995...The Titans are 72-30 (.703) at home and 58-45-1 on the road (.550) under Norm Eash...The 46 losses have come to Wheaton (8); Augustana (8); Millikin (6); North Central (5); Carthage (5); Elmhurst (3); Simpson, UW-Eau Claire, Mt. St. Joseph and Coe (2); and Mount Union, UW-LaCrosse, and Washington U. (1)... Last year IWU finished 7-3 overall and earned a share of the CCIW championship for the first time since 2001. It was IWU's 13th league title ... IWU's last three consecutive losing seasons before 2004-06 were 1941-43...2004 and 2005 were the first back-to-back losing seasons since 1987 (4-5) and 1988 (4-5)...In 2004, IWU (3-7) had its first sub-.500 season since 1993 (4-5). The Titans had been at .500 or better for 10 straight years.

COACH NORM EASH: Norm Eash (Illinois Wesleyan, 1975) is in his 22nd season at IWU and has a career record of 131-75-1 (.633), making him second among IWU coaches in victories (Eash's college coach, Don Larson, had 168 wins from 1954-86). Prior to 2006, Eash ranked 50th among all-time Division III coaches in winning percentage and 67th in victories (24th among active coaches in wins). The "dean" of league coaches, Eash has been College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin "Coach of the Year" in 2007, 2001, 1996 and 1992. His career CCIW mark is 97-57-1 (.630), making him fourth all-time in victories in the league.

LAST WEEK: Illinois Wesleyan, behind four second half touchdown passes from junior Kraig Ladd

(Shelbyville, Ill., HS), defeated Elmhurst, 35-24, at IWU Stadium on Saturday, Oct. 25. Ladd completed 23 of 34 passes for 330 yards and TD passes to Jack Scalcucci (Batavia, Ill. HS), Rick Podkowa (Glenview, Ill., Niles Notre Dame HS), Tom Almanzo (Elk Grove Village, Ill., Elk Grove HS) and John Meacham (Oak Park, Oak Park-River Forest HS). Travis Brubaker (Mt. Prospect, Ill., Hersey HS) rushed for 84 yards on 11 carries. IWU amassed 423 yards of total offense and the Bluejays had 395, led by the 216 passing yards from Chris Kudyba. Ladd was 17 of 23 in the second half alone. Robert Beauchamp (Cerro Gordo, Ill., HS) led the IWU defense with 12 total tackles while Nick Nikolich (Libertyville, Ill., HS) had nine and Neal Loftus (LaGrange Park, Ill. Lyons Township HS) made seven tackles and had an interception.

LEAGUE HONORS: Junior quarterback Kraig Ladd and senior defensive back Robert Beauchamp were CCIW offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, on Oct. 27. Ladd (Shelbyville, Ill., HS) threw for four second half TDs to four different receivers to bring Wesleyan out of a 10-7 halftime deficit, leading the Titans to a 35-24 win over Elmhurst Oct. 25. Ladd was 17-of-23 for 248 yards in the second half alone, and for the game, was 23-of-34 for 330 yards (the 14th best in an Illinois Wesleyan game). Beauchamp (Cerro Gordo, Ill., HS) made 11 solo tackles and assisted on one in the win. He had a quarterback sack for -6 yards and made two other tackles for losses, totaling -6.

KRAIG LADD: The junior southpaw is moving up the ranks of IWU career passing leaders. He is No. 4 in percentage (.574, 306 of 533), No. 5 in completions (306), No. 8 in yards (3,514) and tied at No. 7 with 35 TD passes...He is also No. 10 with 3,563 total offense yards...Ladd tied a school record with six touchdown passes in the 48-34 win over Alma Sept. 13. Ladd completed 17 of 26 passes for 272 yards in tying the TD passing efforts by Lon Erickson (North Park, 1995) and Brad Forsyth (Carroll, 1989).

MARTIN CEISEL: Senior Martin Ceisel (Deerfield, Ill. HS) is No. 4 all-time at IWU with 2,831 receiving yards (No. 3 is Ed Brady, 2,907, 1981-84), No. 3 with 29 receiving touchdowns and No. 4 with 187 receptions (No. 3 is Brady, 220).

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: North Central defeated Wheaton, 44-21, in a CCIW road game last weekend. The Cardinals (7-0, 4-0 College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) took control of the contest early and never relented, owning a 23-0 halftime lead and pulling ahead by as many as 30 points in the second half. Junior Aaron Fanthorpe completed 18 of 28 passes for 294 yards, while also running for 45 yards on 10 carries, and junior Dominic Sulo rushed for 100 yards on 25 carries. Sophomore Steve Hlavac caught five passes for 63 yards, while Kyle Fiedorowicz made four grabs for 78 yards and Hank Johnston caught four passes for 72 yards. Matt Wenger led North Central in tackles for the seventh straight game, making nine stops, while also turning in 3.5 tackles for loss and two quarterback sacks. Derek Sulo made seven tackles and Janecek and Nick Hicks each finished with six...Freshman Andrew Barciszewski was the CCIW special teams player of the week after accounting for 14 points in the victory at Wheaton. He connected on three field goals, tying a North Central single-game record, and made all five of his extra-point attempts.

THE SERIES VS. THE CARDINALS: In a series that dates back to 1945, IWU leads North Central, 36-19-3 and have won 20 of the last 27 meetings. The Titans had won 14 straight games against the Cardinals before losing the last five seasons, including a 23-7 loss in Naperville last season.

CCIW IN THE POLLS: North Central is No. 4 and Wheaton is No. 16 in the AFCA Division III poll (Oct. 28)...In the D3Football.com Top 25, North Central is No. 2 (up from No. 7) and Wheaton fell to No. 15 (from No. 4). D3Football.com is a website devoted strictly to the coverage of NCAA Division III football, which releases a top 25 poll that's voted on by a panel of 25 coaches, sports information directors

and media members from across the country...The Titans were No. 40 in the preseason D3football.com poll.

IWU'S 2008 CCIW HONORS: Senior kicker Joe Duffy (Oak Lawn, Ill., Brother Rice High School) was CCIW special teams player of the week for his play vs. Hope Sept. 6. He had field goals of 39 and 36 yards in the 28-25 win. His 39-yard field goal came just 59 seconds into the game to give the Titans a 3-0 lead. His 36-yard field goal came with 1:51 to play to stake IWU to a 28-19 lead and proved to be the margin of victory as Hope scored a minute later. Duffy also added two extra-point kicks.

UNDER THE LIGHTS: The Titans were 1-1 in night games in 2008 and played the latest night game on the calendar at home in at least 43 years (Oct. 25). In 2007, IWU defeated Augustana, 22-19; in 2005, IWU topped Chicago, 20-13; in 2003, the Titans downed Chicago, 30-21, and in 2002, IWU won its first overtime game in a 31-24 decision over Washington U. The Titans were to have played Aurora at night on Sept. 15, 2001, but the game was cancelled after the national tragedies of Sept. 11. Before 2002, the last home night game was on Oct. 2, 1971, when Carthage downed the Titans, 22-19.

FAST START: The Titans were 3-0 for the first time since 2002 when they started with four straight wins (at Wis.-LaCrosse, 35-31; Washington U., 31-24 in OT; at Chicago, 34-16; North Park, 49-9).

CCIW VS. NON-CCIW: Teams from the CCIW were 19-5 in three weeks of nonconference play in 2008.

HOMECOMING: After the loss to Carthage, the Titans are 28-16 in their last 44 Homecoming games and have been 10-11 in the last 21 years, preceded by a six-game winning streak from 1982-87.

SEASON OPENERS: With the win at Hope on Sept. 6, IWU is 11-11 in opening-day games under Norm Eash. Prior to last weekend, the Titans had dropped their last five season openers, last winning in 2002 (35-31 at Wisconsin-LaCrosse).
