**NCAA TOURNAMENT:** Illinois Wesleyan (15-6) plays Rhodes (14-4-1) in the first round of the NCAA Division III championships in St. Louis on Saturday, Nov. 15 at 7:30 p.m. The winner of that match would play on Sunday, Nov. 16 at 6 p.m. against the winner between host school Washington U. (14-3-1) and Principia (19-1) for the right to advance to the sectional... The winner of the CCIW regular season title, IWU last played in the NCAA event in 2005, losing a 1-0 first round decision at Loras.

**HEAD COACH DAVE BARRETT:** Dave Barrett has been the Illinois Wesleyan women's soccer coach since April 2000 and has been the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin women's soccer "Coach of the Year" three times (2002, 2003 and 2008). Since starting at IWU, Barrett has coached one NCAA Division III All-American, one Academic All-American, 10 all-Central region selections, and 43 Titans have earned all-conference honors... In his eighth year, Barrett's teams have compiled an overall record of 98-43-15 (.676 winning percentage) with a conference-only mark of 37-14-5 (.705). His 2005 team became the first IWU soccer team (of any gender) ever to be selected to play in the NCAA Division III championship tournament... The 2006 Titans were ranked as high as No. 24 in the National

Soccer Coaches Association Division III poll. The 2002 Titans were the CCIW tourney runners-up and were ranked No. 9 in the final Central Region poll. The 2004 team earned national votes midseason and played in the inaugural Midwest Association of Athletic Conferences postseason tournament...For four seasons (2000-04), Barrett coached both the men's and women's teams at IWU, relinquishing the men's job after the 2004 campaign. His four-year men's overall record was 25-43-5 (.377) with a league mark of 6-17-2 (.280).

**EUROPEAN TRAVEL:** The Illinois Wesleyan soccer team went 2-1 on a European exhibition trip in May/June of this year... The team defeated USK Hof by a 4-3 score in Salzburg, Austria on May 31; lost 8-0 to Sparta Prague in Prague, Czech Republic on June 3; and beat FC Puchheim by a 3-1 margin in Munich, Germany on June 7.

**2008 ALL-CONFERENCE:** Seniors Caroline Leighton and Tina Rodriguez were chosen to the first team and four teammates earned second team honors as the all-College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin women's soccer teams were announced on Monday, Nov. 10. Named to the second team were sophomore keeper Alli Novak, sophomore defender Tori Samson, freshman forward Molly O'Brien and freshman defender Lauren Knaack. Leighton, who was second in the league with 16 points, has been a second team all-CCIW selection for the past three seasons and Rodriguez is a first team all-conference selection for the third straight year. Novak led the league with a 0.30 goals-against average and with a .946 save percentage while O'Brien was fourth in the CCIW with 13 points. IWU coach Dave Barrett was the co-winner of the "Coach of the Year" honors, sharing the award with Wheaton's Pete Felske.

**CAROLINE LEIGHTON:** In the Illinois Wesleyan career record book, senior Caroline Leighton ranks No. 4 in both points scored (95) and goals (41)...Leighton is also tied for No. 11 with 13 career assists and is No. 2 all-time with 198 career shots attempted...Has played in 79 games in career and one more will make her the IWU all-time leader, eclipsing 79 by Amy Slott and Emily castner (both 2003-06)...Leighton was a second team all-conference honoree for three seasons before earning first team honors this season...Was once the "Offensive Player of the Week" in the CCIW this season.

**TINA RODRIGUEZ:** The senior defender was a first team all-conference selection as a sophomore, junior and senior...Was once the "Defensive Player of the Week" in the CCIW this season...Third team all-Central region in 2006.

**ALLI NOVAK:** In the Illinois Wesleyan career record book, sophomore goalkeeper Alli Novak ranks No. 1 with 4.38 saves per game (in 39 career games)...Novak is No. 4 with a 0.89 goals against average, No. 4 with 14 shutouts and No. 2 with 171 career saves...Her two-year record is 22-14-3 and the 22 wins in fourth best in an Illinois wesleyan career...Was once the "Defensive Player of the Week" in the CCIW this season...Her 15 wins is tied for most in an IWU single season.

**ELIZABETH SINCLAIR:** In the Illinois Wesleyan career record book, junior Elizabeth Sinclair is No. 14 with 46 points scored and tied for No. 12 with 19 goals...She is No. 4 all-time with 127 shots attempted... Her 59 shots attempted is sixth most in an IWU season...Was a second team all-conference selection in 2007.

**MOLLY O'BRIEN:** Tied for team-best with 10 goals this season and her 54 shots attempted is seventh most in an IWU season...Was once the "Offensive Player of the Week" in the CCIW this season.
