Notes —

- Units Generated Includes enrollment in Gateway, the Humanities sequence, and non-crosslisted courses in ES and IS. Interdisciplinary or Gateway units taught by adjuncts are not credited to departments.
- Student classifications defined by CUs earned, using Catalog definitions; undecided and interdisciplinary majors not counted in any department.
- Since there are no tenure lines allocated to interdisciplinary programs in 2012-13, these programs do not appear on the ratios report. For reference, the two largest interdisciplinary programs are International Studies (49 majors) and Environmental Studies (52 majors).
