Transforming Lives

THROUGH THE STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- **May Term Abroad Scholarship**, \$1,000 per scholarship.
Funds one May Term abroad for one student.
- **Semester Abroad Scholarship**, \$2,500 per scholarship. Funds one semester abroad for one student.
- **Endowed May Term Abroad Scholarship**, \$20,000 per scholarship.
Provides support for a May Term abroad for one student per year in perpetuity.

- **Endowed Semester Abroad Scholarship**, \$50,000 per scholarship, which would fund one scholarship per year in perpetuity.

Note: Endowments can be built over multiple years.
