- February 24–March 21, 2021 — Selected students contact sites and arrange for video interviews
- March 29, 2021 – **IWU administration makes final decision about summer travels; students informed on March 30**
- March 31, 2021 — Confirmation of internship placement. Immediately thereafter, students should have passport ready to work with Dr. Amoloza or Stacey Shimizu to obtain the proper visa. Students should also start correspondence with internship supervisor in Asia.

- April 15, 2021 — Deadline for completion of **mandatory** pre-departure orientation Moodle course
