REQUIRED EDUCATIONAL STUDIES COURSES

*Registration for student teaching courses is contingent upon successful TEP status review conducted after spring grades are entered and a passing scores on the content test is posted in your ELIS account.

Register for:

EDUC 490 Student teaching seminar

AND

The one course below that corresponds to your discipline. Student teaching courses are 3 units of credit.

EDUC 491 Student teaching - English

EDUC 492 Student teaching - Social Science/History

EDUC 493 Student teaching - Foreign Language ~ *Consult with department about OPI exam date

EDUC 494 Student teaching - Mathematics

EDUC 495 Student teaching - Natural Science

EDUC 496 Student teaching – Elementary

- No additional courses are permitted while student teaching.
- It is strongly recommended that student teachers limit work hours beyond 10 per week.
- Student teaching takes precedence over all extra-curricular activities.
- Student teachers pursuing a fall sport must sign a contract stipulating their schedule and plans to make up missed time at school. See Ms. Crider if you are in this situation.

SELF-STUDY

Collect data to be used in a Self-Study completed during EDUC 498 in the spring semester of Senior year. See TEP handbook for information about the Self-Study.

SUBSEQUENT ENDORSEMENTS

Explore the possibility of earning subsequent endorsements (teaching fields) on your initial PEL.

All students seeking a Middle School endorsement must complete content area requirements AND a breakout curriculum and pedagogy seminar in the same area.

- **In planning for the spring of 2022, if taking more than one breakout seminar, one must petition to overload as the two .5 seminars equate to an additional course. A petition is not necessary if only one breakout session is needed.**

STUDENT TEACHING COMPLETION

By the end of the fall semester senior year:

- A signed copy of your student teaching evaluation will be submitted to the TEP by your University Supervisor
- All coursework for EDUC 490 (student teaching seminar) must be completed
- A letter of reference should be requested from your cooperating teacher and IWU supervisor.
- An email evaluation of your cooperating teacher and IWU supervisor should be completed.

In addition, you must pass the Content test in the area you are seeking licensure in order to be licensed.
