

Curriculum Council Committee Report (16 October 2019)

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The Curriculum Council has met seven times since the September faculty meeting. Since the last meeting we have reviewed 26 requests for action. We bring 5 motions to the faculty for a vote today.

The Council continues discussion of the current policy on double counting of courses between majors and minors. CC is in the process of drafting a motion to present to the faculty regarding a change in double counting policy to permit limited double counting between majors and minors.

On September 26, CC was asked by Provost Brodl and Associate Provost Duke to review and comment on 7 documents related to the mandated review of academic programs. The bulk of meetings since that time have been devoted to reviewing, discussing, and recommending edits of those documents that will be used to guide the academic review process. CC is working closely with CUPP in these efforts.
