Guidelines for Transfer Credit

This guide is not intended to be an exhaustive list of all coursework eligible for transfer to IWU, nor a comprehensive list of policies that govern the transfer of coursework. Information regarding graduation requirements, general education, majors and minors can be found in the *Illinois Wesleyan University Catalog* at <https://www.iwu.edu/academics/Catalog.html>. Specific questions may be directed to the IWU Registrar’s Office at registrar@iwu.edu.

- Students must earn a grade of “C” or better to earn IWU credit.
- Courses must be valued at a minimum of 3 semester hours to earn IWU general education, major, or minor credit. IWU uses a course unit system wherein one course unit is equivalent to 4 semester hours.
- Online courses will not be accepted for the general education natural science lab or second language requirements.
- Courses graded pass/fail will not be accepted.
- Courses for major or minor credit must be reviewed by the appropriate department chair.
