You may earn a maximum of 8 course units from a combination of credit by exam (AP) and college courses (dual credit) taken while completing high school. A maximum of four course units can qualify for general education credit. IWU is on the unit system (An IWU course unit is defined as being equal to 4 semester hours. Therefore, a 3 semester hour course equals .75 course units.)

IWU participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). If you attend Heartland and complete an IAI Associate Degree, IWU will accept that as a general education package. Please see the Heartland Community College transfer plans for more information.

AP course with scores of 4 or 5 are accepted and dual credit courses must have grade of “C” or better to be accepted.

Career and technical education courses will not transfer. Transfer electives such as Career Success and Personal Success will not transfer for credit to Illinois Wesleyan.
