You may earn course units from a combination of credit by exam (AP) and college courses (dual credit) taken while completing high school. IWU is on the unit system (An IWU course unit is defined as being equal to 4 semester hours. Therefore, a 3 semester hour course equals .75 course units.)

IWU participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). If you attend Heartland and complete an IAI Associate in Arts Degree, IWU will accept that as a general education package. Please see the Heartland Community College transfer plans for more information.

AP courses with scores of 3, 4, or 5 are accepted and dual credit courses must have a grade of “C” or better to be accepted.
