You may earn course units from a combination of credit by exam (AP) and college courses (dual credit) taken while completing high school. IWU is on the unit system (An IWU course unit is defined as being equal to 4 semester hours. Therefore, a 3 semester hour course equals .75 course units.)

AP courses with scores of 3, 4, or 5 are accepted and dual credit courses must have grade of “C” or better to be accepted.
