You may earn a maximum of 8 course units from a combination of credit by exam (AP) and college courses (dual credit) taken while completing high school. A maximum of four course units can qualify for general education credit. IWU is on the unit system (An IWU course unit is defined as being equal to 4 semester hours. Therefore, a 3 semester hour course equals .75 course units.)

AP course with scores of 4 or 5 are accepted. Dual credit courses must have grade of “C” or better to be accepted.
