In this plan, if you have not already completed additional coursework through AP credit or dual credit, you will leave Heartland missing one Social and Behavioral Sciences course. You may complete that requirement at IWU and through the reverse transfer process, you will complete the requirements at Heartland. In choosing courses, please work with your advisor to complete the IWU Encountering Diversity requirement. Those requirements are detailed below.

• Complete both BIOL 161 & BIOL 162 with a C or better to be equivalent to IWU 101 & 102 and complete both CHEM 161 & CHEM 162 with a C or better to be equivalent to IWU 201 & 202.

- Both 212 and 216 should be completed by the end of the junior year; ideally during the fall semester if possible.
- Six additional courses are required at the 300 or 400 -level. Courses should be selected to meet the following criteria for the degree: one course in each of the **bolded** topics above plus additional major electives to complete the six courses. At least one course should meet the writing intensive requirement.
- Students are encouraged to work with their advisor in order to select appropriate courses to meet these requirements. A possible course pattern is provided.
- To meet IWU graduation requirements choose one course from each group. 1 US Diversity (CHLD 207, Film 211, HIST 135, 136, 210, MUSI 260, POS 101, SOC 110, SOC 135, or SOC 221) and 1 Global Diversity (ANTH 101, HIST 150, HUMA 210, HUMA 270, MUSI 160, POS 151, JAPN 202, SPAN 202) while at Heartland.
- AP scores of 3, 4, or 5 and Standard level IB scores of 5 or higher will receive 1 unit of credit.
- The IWU Second Language requirement can be met by completing the intermediate level (201) course of any language or by earning a 4 or 5 on the AP exam in a second language. Visit the IWU website for information: https://www.iwu.edu/registrar/transfer-credit-faq.html
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, the remedial course will not transfer to IWU. College Algebra, College Trigonometry and Precalculus will not transfer to IWU. Adjust course schedule accordingly to complete degree.

- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or PE courses, at HCC to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of 4 years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- IWU graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level (300/400) courses. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
