It is recommended that you complete the IAI GECC through Heartland. Meeting all of the GECC requirements will automatically meet the Illinois Wesleyan general education requirements. In this plan, you will leave Heartland missing two courses to complete the GECC; one Social and Behavioral Sciences course, and one course in the Humanities/Fine Arts area. You may take those requirements at IWU and through the reverse transfer process, you will complete the requirements at Heartland. In choosing those courses, please work with your advisor to also complete the IWU Encountering Diversity requirement. Those requirements are detailed below.

- At Heartland, choose a (G) Global Diversity and a (U) US Diversity course from recommended list to meet IWU graduation requirements.
- AP scores with 4 of higher, or higher level IB scores of 5 or higher, can be used to meet general education requirements at IWU, but not major or minor requirements.
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete degree.
- Completion of any 201 language course would complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> language requirement.
- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or equivalent PE courses, at Heartland to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses, and 18 courses and 18 units outside the major. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
